## What is it?

## Cooking Champion

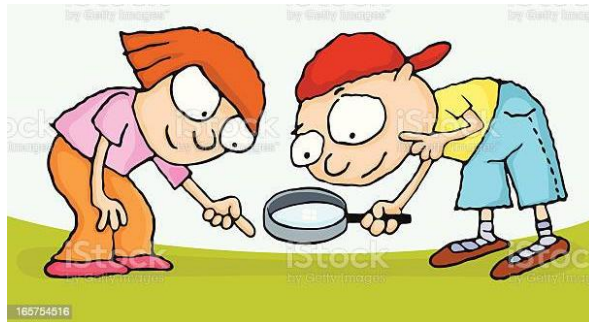


It is summer time and we want you guys to get cooking for a BBQ with your friends and your family.
